Complete project and installation to occur in the Fourth Quarter in Plainfield, Illinois.

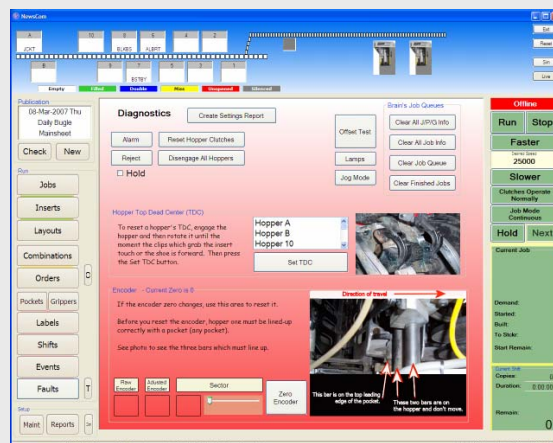

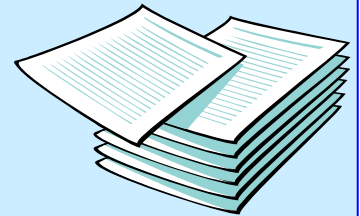

The Record Searchlight also runs two Quipp Model 501 Narrow Stackers.

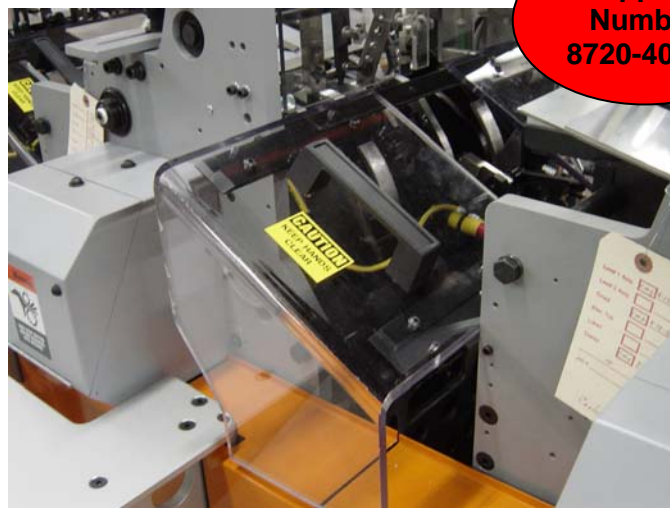

1) SLS Hopper Lexan Guarding with NO Interlocks

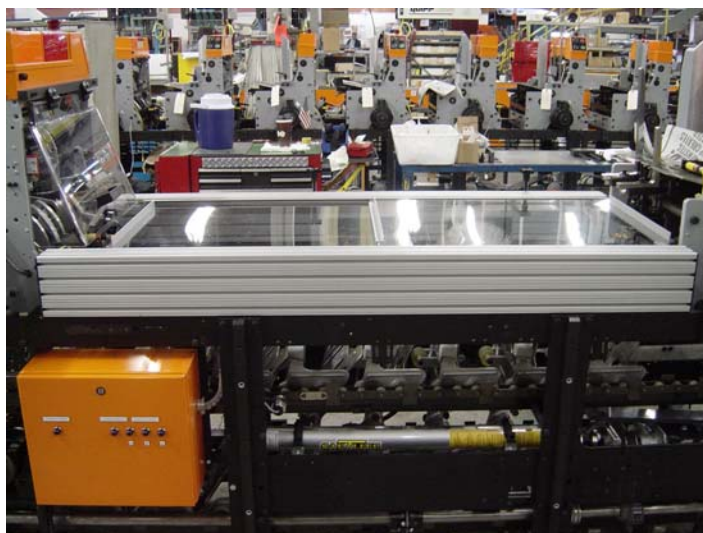
Between hopper guards – E-Stop must first be depressed on hopper, Hex screw removed, slides out sideways
