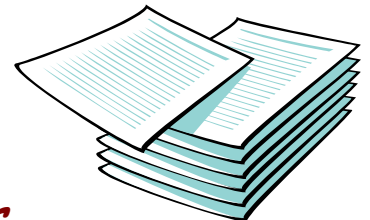

Quipp Stacker Light Curtain Safety Kits are designed to prevent injury to an operator who inadvertently extends a hand or other object into the lower operating area of a stacker. A non-visible "wall" of light is directed across the bundle delivery path(s) of a stacker. Should any object interrupt this light curtain, the stacker turntable valve is instantly disabled.

Quipp Stacker Light Curtain Safety Kits are available for retrofitting onto existing QUIPP 30X, 35X and 40X Series Newspaper Stackers.
