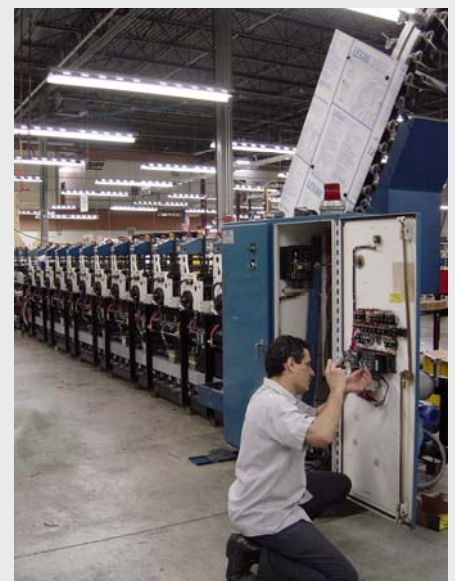
The equipment will be installed in their facility in Pittsfield, MA in the first quarter of 2008.

Below: **Orestes Arcia**, a Quipp Electrical Assembler working on the inserter electrical panel



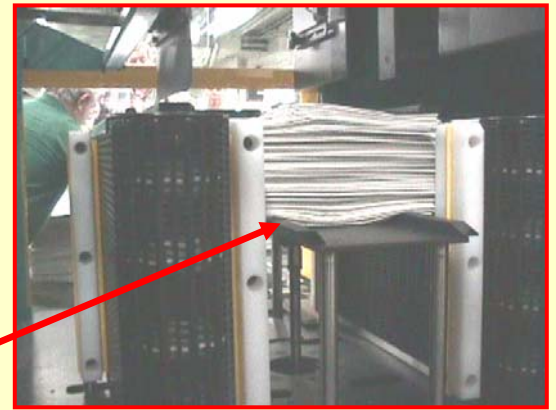

A lift plate on its turntable compresses the stacks, removing most of the air trapped between pages and copies, producing improved bundle integrity.

Quipp Stacker Light Curtain Safety Kits are available for retrofitting onto existing QUIPP 300/301, 350/351 and 400/401 Series Newspaper Stackers.

Quipp Stacker Light Curtain Safety Kits are designed to prevent injury to an operator who inadvertently extends a hand or other object into the lower operating area of a stacker. A non-visible "wall" of light is directed across the bundle delivery path(s) of a stacker. Should any object interrupt this light curtain, the stacker turntable valve is instantly disabled.

A detailed installation instruction is included in the kit complete with a short, easy to understand installation procedure video.

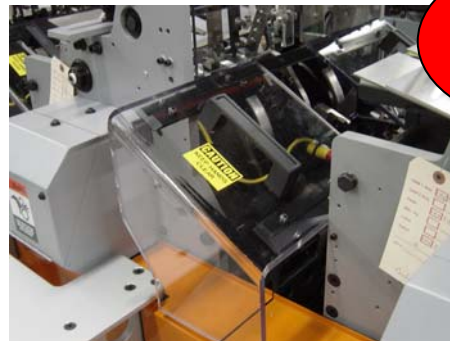
Quipp sold Safety Enhancement Kits to *Scripps Treasure Coast Newspapers* for their existing SLS-1000® Inserter.

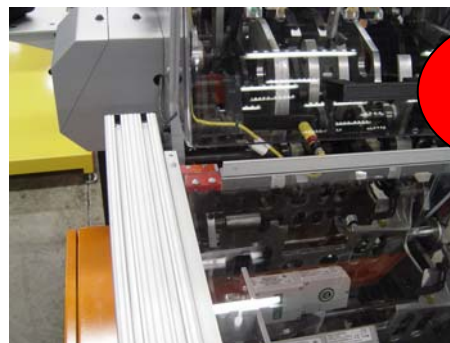

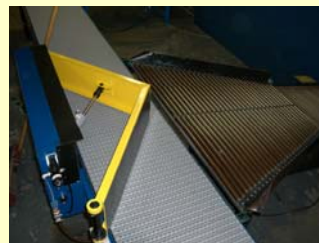

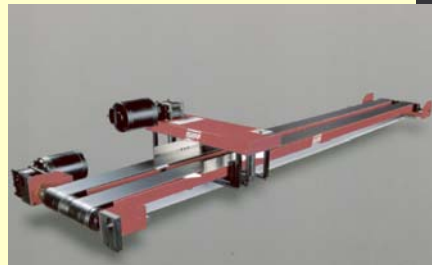
Dear Quipp Customer,
