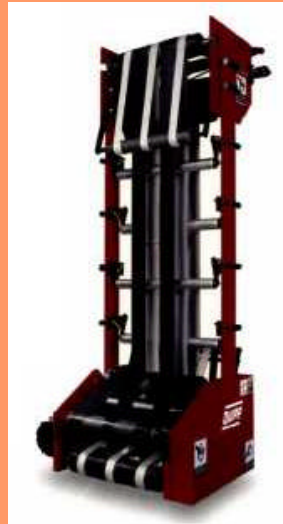


## Quipp sells mailroom projects to *Palm Springs, CA, Rockford, IL & Auckland, New Zealand*

Quipp received a major order from *The Desert Sun* (a Gannett newspaper), for Twin-Trak Belt Conveyor Systems, Stacker and Bottomwrapper equipment, a Bundle Distribution System (BDS) and Controls.

The Quipp Twin-Trak Belt Conveyor will replace the existing IDAB Belt Conveyors.

The equipment will be installed in their *Palm Springs, CA* facility this fall.



Quipp just received an order from *The Rockford (IL) Register Star* for the following equipment:

- (3) 501 Narrow Stackers
- (2) Viper Bottomwrappers
- (2) Rollerslat Conveyors with Pacers
- (2) Incline Mattetop Conveyors with Powered Gates
- (1) Powered Deflector
- (2) Waste Conveyors with a Steel Chute



*The Rockford (IL) Register Star* is adding a new press to their production facility and needed to add two new tielines and modify the existing bundle distribution conveyors. Each tieline will consist of a Quipp 501 Narrow Stacker, a Quipp Viper Bottomwrapper, a Rollerslat Conveyor with a Pacer, Strappers, and an inclined mattetop conveyor with a powered gate. These tielines will accept either ROP or Inserted product that will then be directed to one of six (6) Powered Truckloaders.

*The Rockford (IL) Register Star*, a Gannett newspaper, is currently using four (4) Quipp 401 Narrow Stackers and three (3) Viper Bottomwrappers.

Quipp received an order from the *Horton Media* in Auckland, New Zealand for **Twin-Trak Belt Conveyor Systems** & a **Waste Conveyor System**. One belt conveyor system will be installed from their existing press and the other conveyor from their new press to their existing stackers.

The *Horton Media* team came to the US last month to visit many existing Quipp customers, which run similar applications. After these visits, they came to Miami to visit our production facility and meet our personnel.

The equipment will be installed in the Fall 2005.

"Attached are various pictures from different angles using the snap in blocks installed on our Quipp Model 500 Stackers that we purchased in 2004. The blocks are built as to snap into the pusher frame and can be switched out in a number of minutes. Changes from one size to another only require unsnapping of three blocks and replacing them with three others of different size (tool-less operation). The various size blocks enable us to **quickly switch** from one stock size to another and **maintain a perfectly stacked ejected bundle**. **There is no need to have staff stand next to each line anymore to make sure that the bundles are stacked straight. We know they will come out straight."**



**The Quipp Pusher Spacers provide great flexibility if you are running different paper sizes.**

**Quipp Pusher Spacer Kits** include one set of six pusher blades to be permanently mounted on the rotating turntable walls. A set of two mount fittings on each pusher blade then permit quick installation of the six sets of spacers correctly sized for the product to be stacked.

**Spacers are available in 1/4" width increments from 1/2" to 2".**

**All new Quipp Model 500 Stackers are equipped with this feature.**
